# Living with the impact of Climate Change?



The challenge of climate change

- Weather patterns hardly predictable;
- Events more frequent and harsh;
- Vulnerable people suffers even more!
- Mozambique is among the world's top 10 nations to be the worst affected by climate change and the first in Africa! (Global Climate Index 2021)





Urbanization or Slumization?





### Urbanization

- Population of Mozambique is growing at the rate of 2.9% per year;
- The Urban population is about 37% of the total and it's growing by 4.4 % per year;
- The informal settlements are growing!


• In about 20 years the urban population may represent 50% of total.



#### How to address the climate change challenge?

- Mandatory gradual holistic planning The Integrated Urban Water Management (IUWM);
- At utility level Water Safety Plans integrating climate change risk assessment, enforced by the Regulator;
- A new approach to infrastructure: redundancy; flexibility; decentralized solutions; household/community based initiatives; technology for all!
- Capacitate institutions and technicians!

#### How to address the urbanization challenge?

- Accept the growth of slums and the limitations of the conventional approaches to service those areas;
- The slums are not a transitory situation;
- Planning of infrastructure and service provision should be "slum-centric" and inclusive;
- The model for service provision should follow the market segmentation and cope with the informal economy environment.



Research and **Planning for resilient water services** and to reach all, needs new approaches, continuity, skilled organization and staff – **A specific investment allocation is essential!**
